

## TERMS & CONDITIONS - All entries

1. Entries are limited to ONE PER CATEGORY PER ARTIST. There is no limit to the number of categories an artist can enter. You can enter online at [www.taranakiartawards.co.nz](http://www.taranakiartawards.co.nz)
2. Each entry must be accompanied by a **\$20 entry fee**.  
*This fee is non-refundable.*

3. Commission of 25% will be charged on all sales and **MUST BE INCLUDED in the sale price on your entry form**. If you do not want to sell your artwork, write **NFS (Not For Sale)** on your entry form.  
**Note:** We do not accept POA (Price On Application).
4. Two printed labels for each artwork will be enclosed with your receipt of entry. Please attach ONE label to the back right hand corner of your artwork/s OR as a swing tag and ONE label to the outside packaging of your artwork/s.
5. Artists are responsible for insurance for their artworks. All care will be taken but no liability for artwork damage by the organisers.
6. Entries will be judged in the category in which they are entered. If artwork/s are ineligible for the entered category, the artist will be contacted by the organisers.
7. The committee has the right to refuse offensive or inappropriate material.
8. All entries **MUST BE READY TO HANG OR DISPLAY**. Please refer to **Artist Guidelines** for specific definitions. Work not ready to hang will be disqualified. All entries must be of a size easily handled by two people – if your work is large or heavy, please contact the organisers.
9. Incorrect entry procedure or failure to observe the conditions herein may at the discretion of the organisers disqualify an entry.
10. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence can be entered into. The judging panel is independent of the organisers.
11. All entrants receive a complimentary ticket to the Awards Ceremony with receipt of entry. Additional tickets can be purchased from Sandfords Events Centre prior to the event or on the night for \$15.
18. The organisers have the right to use photographs of artwork for promotional and advertising purposes and on the website, unless specified by the artist.

## DELIVERY & COLLECTION

1. Entry forms must be received by **Friday 15 September 2017**.
  - **Late entries will not be accepted – no exceptions.**
  - **No Title or Price changes will be accepted after entry closing date.**
2. Artwork/s must be delivered to Sandfords Event Centre, 150 Tasman Street, Opunake, between **10.00am - 4.00pm, 16 – 23 October 2017**.
3. Artwork/s must be securely packaged and delivered free of all charges with a return PRE-PAID freight ticket included (see **Courier Instructions**). No payment will be made by TNAA for freight or other charges incurred in the delivery or return of exhibits.
4. Artists will be contacted if their artwork is sold. Unsold artworks must be collected from Sandfords Event Centre, 150 Tasman Street, Opunake **10.00am – 4.00pm Sunday 5 November and Monday 6 November 2017**.
5. For courier return of artwork/s you must complete the **Courier Return Form**. Please ensure that you send the form and PRE-PAID ticket separately no later than **25 October 2017**. We will return your courier tickets by post with your cheque if your artwork is sold. Artworks will be return couriered on **Monday 6 November 2017**.
6. After these dates the Taranaki National Art Awards Committee has the right to sell or otherwise dispose of unclaimed work.

## CATEGORY DEFINITIONS 2017

1. **Painting:** Acrylic, oil or mixed media.  
*Multi-part artworks not accepted, e.g diptych.*
2. **Rural Taranaki:** Artist must reside in Taranaki.  
*Any medium.*
3. **3D:** Sculpture in any medium.
4. **Works on Paper:** Any medium, including printmaking.  
*Photography not accepted, except in collage.*
5. **Fibre Art:** Natural or manmade fibres.
6. **Toi Tu Taranaki:** *How Aotearoa New Zealand sees Taranaki. Artists from around New Zealand are invited to reflect on the Taranaki they see, hear or know as perceived from their local place and point of view in Aotearoa.*
7. **Photography - Film or digital**  
*Multi-part artworks not accepted, e.g triptych*
